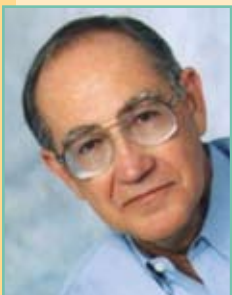
**Paul Anderson** is the Director of Lutheran Renewal (LR) and was a parish pastor for 25 years before he joined LR. For many years his vision was to train the next generation to disciple the nations. The Master's Institute, founded in 2001, is the fruit of that vision. Later, through the pietistic renewal, there was a recovery of a new intimacy with God, which led to a reformation of spirituality, the Second Reformation. 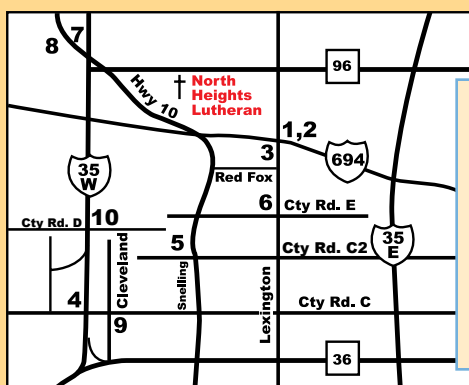

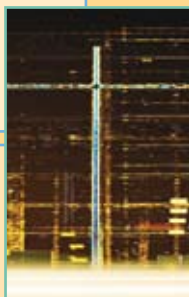
